TORC PRO-SPORTSMAN DOUBLEHEADER AT OSHKOSH WILL SPARKLE UNDER THE LIGHTS JULY 23-24

The TRAXXAS Off-Road Championship, presented by AMSOIL, announced today the addition of the PRO Off-Road Classes to the race ticket alongside the Sportsman Classes at the Oshkosh Speedzone July 23 and 24. The Traxxas Off-Road Championship offers spectacular competition in a crowd-pleasing format and this event on a track design fueled by technical advancement is expected to be explosive in its ability to energize race fans in the Fox Valley of Wisconsin.

Leading up to the world-famous Oshkosh AirVenture, the world's greatest aviation celebration planned for July 26-August 1, the Fox Valley's premier dirt track will host off-road racing for the third straight year after a 12-year hiatus. Home to a majority of TORC Series Sportsman teams, Fox Valley is also home to the "Flying Dutchman" Vanden Heuvel Team, which is instrumental in this event's organization and is celebrating 32 years in the sport of off-road racing.
